Since the beginning of the year, I have allowed students to take their GPS and we then correct it as a class and students receive partial credit for their corrections. These retakes will occur during remediation on Tuesdays and Thursdays of the following week to avoid loss of instruction time. If you have any questions about this, please let me know.
